Anchorage Christian Schools is an academically competitive school. GPA is based on a 4.0 scale.

AP courses receive a maximum of 5 points.

GPA is figured by averaging all of the classes that a student takes each semester. Rank is based on the student's cumulative GPA.

The AP Calculus and AP English Literature are our most advanced college prep courses. Other courses considered to be college prep are Algebra II, chemistry, advanced chemistry/physics, and anatomy.

Over the past five years approximately 60-75% of our graduates enroll in a four year college or university. Approximately 25-40% join the military, attend a two year program or trade school, or join the work force.

**Current Statistics:**

Junior/Senior High School Statistics 2017-2018 school year

Secondary enrollment is 182 students. 59 students are in junior high and 113 students are in high school. 56% of the secondary student body is male. The ethnic breakdown is as follows: 58% Caucasian, 9% African-American, 8% American Indian/Alaska Native, 2% Hispanic, 8% Asian, 10% Multi-racial, 5% Hawaiian/Pacific Islander.

The average secondary school class size is approximately 21 students.

Approximately 40% of our student body belongs to our sponsoring church, Anchorage Baptist Temple. Approximately 70 church groups are represented by the remainder of the student body.
